MASONIC HOMES – UNION CITY & COVINA

- Independent living
- Assisted living
- Skilled nursing*
- Memory care*

*Covina coming in 2022

Eligibility:

- CA Master Mason age 60+
- In good standing for the past 5 consecutive years at the time of application
- The 60+ spouse/widow/mother of eligible Mason

Financing options:

- 75% of assets and income are assigned to the Masonic Homes, applicant retains 25%
- Fee for service (Various Options with financial qualifiers)

MASONIC SENIOR OUTREACH SERVICES (MSOS)

AGES 60+

• Care Management

- Support with navigating community resources
- Guidance & hands-on assistance

No time limit

• Financial Care Management

- Care management plus:
- On-going financial support (when income requirements met)
- Agreement to repay
- Skilled nursing level not approved, as its covered by MediCal

Eligibility Requirements:

- A California Mason, his spouse or surviving spouse, his minor or dependent adult children
- For financial program: A California Master Mason of 5 or more years (in good standing), meeting income requirements



MSOS SHARED HOUSING

- *Co-housing program on Covina Masonic Homes campus*
- **Eligibility:**
 - Be an MSOS client
 - At least 62 years of age
 - Independent
 - Limited assets
 - Ability to pass fingerprinting clearance
 - Open to co-housing

MASONIC FAMILY OUTREACH SERVICES (MFOS)

• Care Management

- Support with navigating community resources
- Guidance & hands-on assistance
- No time limit

• Financial Care Management

- One-time financial assistance as a bridge to self-sufficiency
- Must meet financial need criteria
- Provided a Care Manager
- Lodge support is required

Eligibility Requirements:

- A California Mason, his spouse or surviving spouse, his minor or dependent adult children
- For financial program: A California Master Mason of 5 or more years (in good standing), meeting income requirements

DISTRESSED WORTHY BROTHER FUND (EMERGENCY/DISASTER FUND)

- In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Grand Lodge created an **emergency** fund to provide relief to members and their family who have been impacted by the pandemic or another disaster.
- **Eligibility:**
 - Any mason, who is in good standing, that is living in CA regardless of jurisdiction
- **What is provided:**
 - Care Management support, resource identification & guidance on how to access benefits. Short-term financial assistance, if eligible
