Past: "Grand Lodge Police"

2024: Teachers and Coaches of Ritual

2025: Next Step → Mentors of Officers

Not Just Ritual → Leadership, Duties, Administration

Progression: Inspector → Teacher → Coach → Mentor

Why Mentorship Matters

Continuity – Masonic knowledge preserved

Confidence – Officers grow in ability

Commitment – Keeps men stepping forward

Mentorship creates leaders, not placeholders

Concrete Actions

Inspectors as mentors must:

Be **present** at meetings, practices, degrees

Teach **duties**, not just ritual

Model leadership

Ask & **listen** to officers

Encourage **teamwork**

Roll up sleeves to help with ritual & admin
